**Alice Angney Scholarship for Leadership and Service

In 2007, the Vermont Superintendents Association established the Alice Angney Scholarship for Leadership and Service. The scholarship is intended to recognize one Vermont high school senior with a financial award of \$1,000 dollars.

About Alice Angney

Alice Angney has served public education and the children of Vermont as an educator for more than 40 years. In 2007, after 21 years of service as a superintendent for the Lamoille South Supervisory Union, Dr. Angney retired. Dr. Angney's career can be characterized by devotion to children, dedication to public education, and a demonstrated commitment to excellence. Dr. Angney is a true leader and public servant.

About the Alice Angney Scholarship

In 2012 the Vermont Superintendents Association will award one \$1,000 Alice Angney Scholarship to a deserving Vermont high school senior. The recipient will be chosen by a VSA selection committee on the basis of the student's leadership and service to his or her community, academic achievement, and ***initiative in overcoming a specific challenge***. The recipient will demonstrate a commitment to furthering his or her education after high school.

The selection committee will meet during the month of April to review applications. The scholarship recipient will be notified during the first week of May regarding his/her selection for the award. The scholarship will be paid upon confirmation of the student's enrollment in a post-secondary educational program.

To apply for the Alice Angney Scholarship, students must complete the accompanying application form and return it with the required materials to the Vermont Superintendents Association postmarked not later than Friday, March 23, 2012.
