BY-LAWS

As Amended at a Meeting of the Association - May 13, 2005

ARTICLE I -QUORUM FOR MEETINGS OF THE ASSOCIATION AND MEETINGS OF THE TRUSTEES

Section 1 A quorum for meetings of the Association shall require participation by two-fifths of the active members from the Superintendent/Chief Executive Officer category of the Association for regular or special meetings of the Association.

Section 2 A quorum for regular or special meetings of the board of trustees shall require a majority of the seated trustees.

Section 3 No business shall be transacted by the Association or by the trustees without a quorum. No motion or resolution shall be declared adopted without the concurrence of a majority of the eligible voting members present.

ARTICLE II -COMMITTEES AND TASK FORCES

Section 1 Committees and Task Forces shall be provided with regular opportunities to provide reports to the board of trustees and to the membership.

Section 2 Annually, the board of trustees shall establish charges to guide the work of the Committees and Task Forces.

ARTICLE III -AMENDMENTS

Section 1 Proposed amendments to the Constitution or By-Laws shall be presented in writing to the board of trustees by any active member or by an established committee of the Association.

Section 2 The board of trustees shall be responsible for bringing all proposed amendments to the membership for their consideration at a regular meeting or a special meeting called for that purpose. Proposed amendments shall be included in the notice of the meeting.

Section 3 The adoption of amendments to the Constitution or By-Laws shall require two-thirds vote of the eligible voting members present.

ARTICLE IV -DUES

Annual dues of the Association shall become due on July 1. Any member whose dues are in arrears on September 1st shall be sent a final notice of payment outstanding. Any member whose dues are still in arrears on November 1st shall be dropped from membership in the Association. Members may be reinstated without penalty upon payment of outstanding dues. Under extraordinary circumstances as determined by the board of trustees provisions of this article may be waived.

ARTICLE V - BENEFITS FOR MEMBERS OF THE ASSOCIATION

The Association, by majority vote of its members, may provide group insurance plans, retirement plans, annuity plans, or other such plans for the benefit of the members of the organization.

ARTICLE VI - ANNUAL AUDIT OF THE FINANCIAL ACCOUNTS OF THE ASSOCIATION

The board of trustees shall arrange for an annual audit of the financial accounts of the Association.
